

Tips to Improve Structure of Your Research Paper - 2021

Imagine you have spent long tiring hours in doing research but fail to present to in a legible way, all your efforts go wasted. Even for some writers, writing is not their forte and they are all frustrated by the hefty process.

Remember! *If content is king, then presentation is king-maker.*

Thus, the organization and presentation of ideas are important. Improving the structure of your essay is a great way to enhance the presentation of your research paper. Here are some handful of tips for this by a ['write my essay'](#):

Get Organized

This stage is even before you begin writing. The key is to make an outline of the paper before making the first draft. When you make an outline of your paper, have a clear organization of your data.

Does the information answer the research question? Do you need more research? How the result affect others? Is the information clear and concise? Ask yourself all these questions and organize accordingly.

Take Care of Research Paper Structure

After the first step, the next step is to take care of the paper structure.

I have corrected scores of many research papers and a huge problem is that many students just "dump" all the information onto the page and expect the Instructor to make sense of it all, pick out the relevant gems, as it were, from all the dross.

If you obtain a sample of a research paper from some ['write my essay for me'](#) service, you will see how organized is the information shared in those papers. Expert writers understand that the clear organization of information into different sections of a paper is very important.

Following are the sections of a research paper:

Title:

It informs the readers about the topic of your research and they can get an idea of what to expect in the paper. Always make it clear and interesting.

Abstract:

It is the overall summary of the research paper. It is equally important as the title.

Introduction:

It offers background information on the topic and research.

Body paragraphs:

These paragraphs generally share the research methodologies if it is a research article. In a simple research paper, information collected from different sources is shared with the reader in an organized manner. Each paragraph discusses one point.

Results and Discussion:

the research findings and the results obtained after the analysis of information collection is shared with the reader in this section.

Conclusion:

this section offers the writer's opinion, limitations of the research and the room of further research, etc. in journal articles, there is a separate section for each.

References:

All the sources of information are listed in this section. This list has a corresponding reference for each citation in the text.

Helpful Rules

- It depends in part on what the teacher/professor wants and where you're at academically. It further (somewhat) depends on what type of paper it is, as there are types of papers with different formats.
- Make sure you're completely familiar with your teacher's expectations (if not, ask questions), narrow your topic sufficiently (an inch wide and a foot deep, so to speak), write a rough draft (it's called a rough draft on purpose—it's not meant to be perfect), outline, and write a second draft.
- If possible, have someone look it over before you turn it in, and don't forget to check for grammar and spelling (don't assume your computer's spell check is infallible because it's not).
- If you want to improve your ability to write research papers the most critical point (after mastering the mechanics of spelling, punctuation, and grammar) is to PLAN your paper.

- Allocate enough time to the paper and don't rush through the paper. Good luck with your research papers!
